We offer further education in Value Based Counseling (VBC), a counseling approach which we have been using worldwide successfully for years. VBC is a culturally sensitive short-term psychodynamic intervention which is resource-based, solution-focused and designed for dealing with psychological symptoms resulting from psychosocial stress such as intrapsychic or interpersonal conflicts, traumatic experiences, a disruptive social environment, or difficult life transitions such as migration or loss of livelihoods.

• Your qualifications

- You have a certificate of higher education in psychology, social work/pedagogy or medicine or a similar educational background attained in Germany or abroad.
- You have work experience in a psychosocial context and are motivated to provide culturally sensitive counseling.
- You speak more than one language, including good German or English.

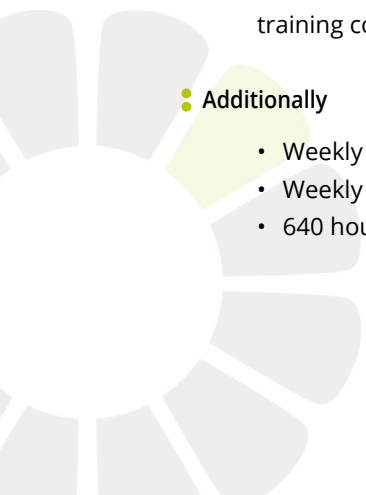
• Further education in VBC

Three months of theoretical training on an eLearning platform including 18 days of self-awareness group in Berlin, followed by a practical phase with 10 supervised counseling cases.

The training is expected to start on 29 March 2021 in English language. A training conducted in German is planned to start around May/June 2021.

• Additionally

- Weekly group supervision throughout the period of training
- Weekly individual supervision based on case reviews
- 640 hours of training



• Contents of the training

The training consists of

1. Knowledge transfer
2. Skills transfer
3. Self-experience and self-reflection

The training is designed to qualify trainees to provide psychosocial counseling and uses methods of modern adult education.

1. Knowledge transfer

Focused on the theoretical foundations of the counseling approach, basic concepts in psychology and psychosocial care.

2. Skills transfer

Focused on communication skills, conversation techniques and psychosocial intervention techniques.

3. Self-experience and self-reflection

Acquired knowledge and skills are reflected on based on personal experiences and observations.

If you complete the training successfully, you can work for Ipso Care dependent on your availability and our capacities. We provide professional supervision of your counseling. You can be paid either as an Ipso staff member or as an unsalaried associate based on the number of counseling sessions you provide.
